



## **Rationale for recommendation**

- Consistent with:
  - The 2040 Regional Parks Policy Plan; State fiscal year 2021 Parks and Trails Legacy Fund (PTLF)
  - appropriation requirements;
  - The Lake Rebecca Park Reserve master plan; and • Three Rivers Park District is within it's \$1.7 million per fiscal year
  - limit for PTLF PAOF funding.

- Authorize the Community Development Director to execute the grant agreement and restrictive covenant on behalf of the Council.
- Consider reimbursing Three Rivers Park District up to \$242,500 from its share of a future Regional Parks Capital Bonding Program.
- Inform Three Rivers Park District that the Council does not under any circumstance represent or guarantee that the Council will grant future reimbursement and that expenditure of local funds never entitles a park agency to reimbursement.
