





## Public Participation Activities

## Strategies to Inform:

- City-wide newsletter sought to reach the city-wide population of 26,385
- Four City meetings and Two open houses: over 1,000 people attended
- County webpage and social media reached more that 20,000 people

## **Strategies to Consult:**

- Survey and preference boards received input from more than 125 respondents
- Open house and listening sessions engaged the general public and Transformative Circle, a local non-profit

- High vehicle speeds
- Snow clearing from sidewalks
- More safe crossings and lighting

#### Cost:






# Estimated Project Costs


Implementation Components	<b>Estimated Costs</b>
