Background

The purpose of this information item is to provide background and support discussion for the 2020 Regional Parks System Bonding Program. The total proposed Bonding Program is \$25 million, which includes a \$15 million Council request to the Governor for inclusion in the 2020 Legislative Session. If passed, the Council's match commitment at this level would be \$10 million. The ten Regional Park Implementing Agencies will present project and equity highlights from this program request.

Equity Toolkit. The Bonding Program under consideration includes a commitment from the Council to work with the ten agencies to understand and document how projects advance equitable use of the Regional Parks System. Each agency identified whether their bonding requests help advance equitable usage of the Regional Parks System. In some instances, the agencies highlight the project's equity component, while in other instances, the agencies indicate that the project was not designed to advance equitable use. The purpose of this exercise is to help foster a system-wide discussion on how we are collectively advancing equitable use in the Regional Parks System, including exploring effective ways to build equity components into capital projects.

A summary of the projects is included in Attachment 1.
