What is a TIP?

- Four-year list of transportation projects funded in whole or part with federal funding
- Must include all projects funded with federal transportation funds and projects that affect air quality prioritized by year
- Required for all Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs)
- Incorporated into MnDOT's Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP)





Key Criteria for TIP and Amendment Approvals

- Consistent with expected funding level fiscally balanced Consistent with regional Transportation Plan (TPP)
- In conformity with Clean Air Act requirements
- Opportunity for public input





Schedule for 2020-2023 TIP

- TAB approves draft for public review June 19, 2019 Public review/comment period ends – Aug 9, 2019 • TAB considers comments, approval – Aug 21, 2019 Transportation Committee – September 9, 2019 Metropolitan Council concurrence – September 25, 2019 MnDOT inclusion into STIP – September/October, 2019

- Federal approvals November 2019



- Federal Highway \$1.3 Billion
- Federal Transit \$1.3 Billion
- Property Tax and State Taxes \$2.0 Billion
- Trunk Highway \$466 million
- TOTAL ~ \$5 Billion
