These instructions explain how to set up your Internet-connected device (smartphone, laptop, desktop, or tablet) so you can receive coded emails in your non-Council account to remotely and securely access your Met Council account.

The instructions continue from the initial multi-factor authentication (MFA) directions you followed to select your two verification options from the four available: authenticator mobile app, phone, email, and security questions. Be sure you read through this before you begin the setup steps.

 If you have already selected Email as your first method (shown in the image at right), then click the "Close" button and go to Step 2. If you need to complete the Email setup or change your second method preference, go back to the main <u>MFA</u> <u>Registration Instructions</u>.
