Notice is given that on Tuesday, September 1, 2009 at 2:00 P.M. the Metropolitan Council will receive and publicly open separate sealed bids for Metro Transit Procurement Number 7981 at their offices located at 515 North Cleveland Avenue, St. Paul, MN, 55114-1878. Sealed bids should be delivered to 2nd Floor Purchasing Department.

The Work of this Project includes replacing existing overhead doors and tracks, by providing and installing a total of four High Speed Doors, at South, Ruter, FTH, and East Metro Garages. All garages will get the same new electrical powered spiral roll up with windows door system. Each new door will be installed at the same existing opening of each facility. The project includes the removal and disposal of existing steel door, salvage curtain doors, relocating conduits, structure construction /modification to support the new doors frame. Owner will provide power/electrical connection for new high speed doors at all 4 locations. Contractor must coordinate this work with owner.

The estimated construction cost is \$240,000.
