Notice is given that on August 31, 2009 at 2:00 P.M. the Metropolitan Council will receive and publicly open separate sealed bids for the Re-bid of Metro Transit Procurement Number 8311 at their offices located at 515 North Cleveland Avenue, St. Paul, MN, 55114-1878. Sealed bids should be delivered to 2nd Floor Purchasing Department.

The Work of this Project includes: Construction of a roundabout at the intersection of Kenrick Avenue and 175<sup>th</sup> Street in Lakeville, MN. This work includes grading, aggregate base, bituminous surfacing, concrete curb and gutter, and storm sewer.

A traffic study prepared for Metro Transit identified this roundabout as a traffic improvement necessary for keeping the intersection at acceptable operating levels with the introduction of the new Kenrick Ave Park and Ride user traffic.

The estimated construction cost is \$450,500.
