The Metropolitan Council is soliciting proposals from firms interested in providing consultant services in support of the Metropolitan Highway System Investment Study (MHSIS). The Council, working with the Minnesota Department of Transportation, will conduct the MHSIS to produce a future investment strategy for the metropolitan trunk highways. A primary goal of the MHSIS study is to develop a “Right-Sized” metropolitan highway investment plan for the next 50 years to aid in long-range planning and project development. The study will determine what can be done to “optimize” the performance of the Metropolitan Highway System and preserve regional mobility given limited funding.

A 15 percent Disadvantaged Business Enterprise participation goal has been established for this contract.
