The Purpose of the CAC is to advise the CCMC and provide input and feedback to Central Corridor Project Office staff on issues related to the planning, design and construction of the Central Corridor LRT project. The CAC's monthly meeting will provide an important vehicle for involving community groups in the design process, addressing project area concerns, facilitating public awareness and identifying ways to mitigate construction impacts.

The responsibilities of the CAC include:
