





## Funding Scenarios

- 1. <u>Base Scenario</u>-Uses mid-point of funding ranges
- Expansion Heavy Scenario (both Roadways and Transit)-Uses mid-point of funding ranges, but with more funding for expansion
- 3. <u>Modernization Heavy Scenario</u> (both Roadways and Transit)-Uses mid-point of funding ranges, but with more funding for modernization
- 4. <u>Bike/Pedestrian Heavy Scenario</u>-Funds this mode at a higher % by shifting \$ from other modes
- 5. Roadways Heavy Scenario-Funds this mode at a higher % by shifting \$ from transit
