
Orange Line Bus Rapid Transit (BRT)

Background

- 12 stations, 17 miles
- All-day, frequent station-to-station BRT and express bus service along I-35W
- Builds on precursor Route 535
- 26,000 daily rides projected by 2040 on I-35W buses
- Provides access to 56,000 jobs and 81,000 residents outside of downtown Minneapolis

Project Status

- Fully funded
- Under construction
- Opening late 2021






Project Budget & Schedule

- All funds secured
- Total project cost stable at \$150.7 million
- Construction of Minneapolis components (35W@94 project) underway since 2017
 - Lake Street Station
 - 12th Street Ramp
- Construction of Knox Avenue Transitway under I-494 began in July 2019
- Construction of BRT Stations begins in Spring 2020
- Open BRT service in Late 2021






Construction Update

- 12th Street Ramp has taken shape at the south end of downtown
- Transit bridge at I-35W & Lake Street is now under construction
- Construction continues for the Knox
 Avenue transit underpass of I-494
 - 2019 activities included utility relocation under and near I-494 to enable underpass construction
 - 2020 construction focuses on north half of transit underpass
 - Highway ramp from SB I-35W to WB
 I-494 will be closed for roughly four months starting in April 2020
