Community Designation Land Area

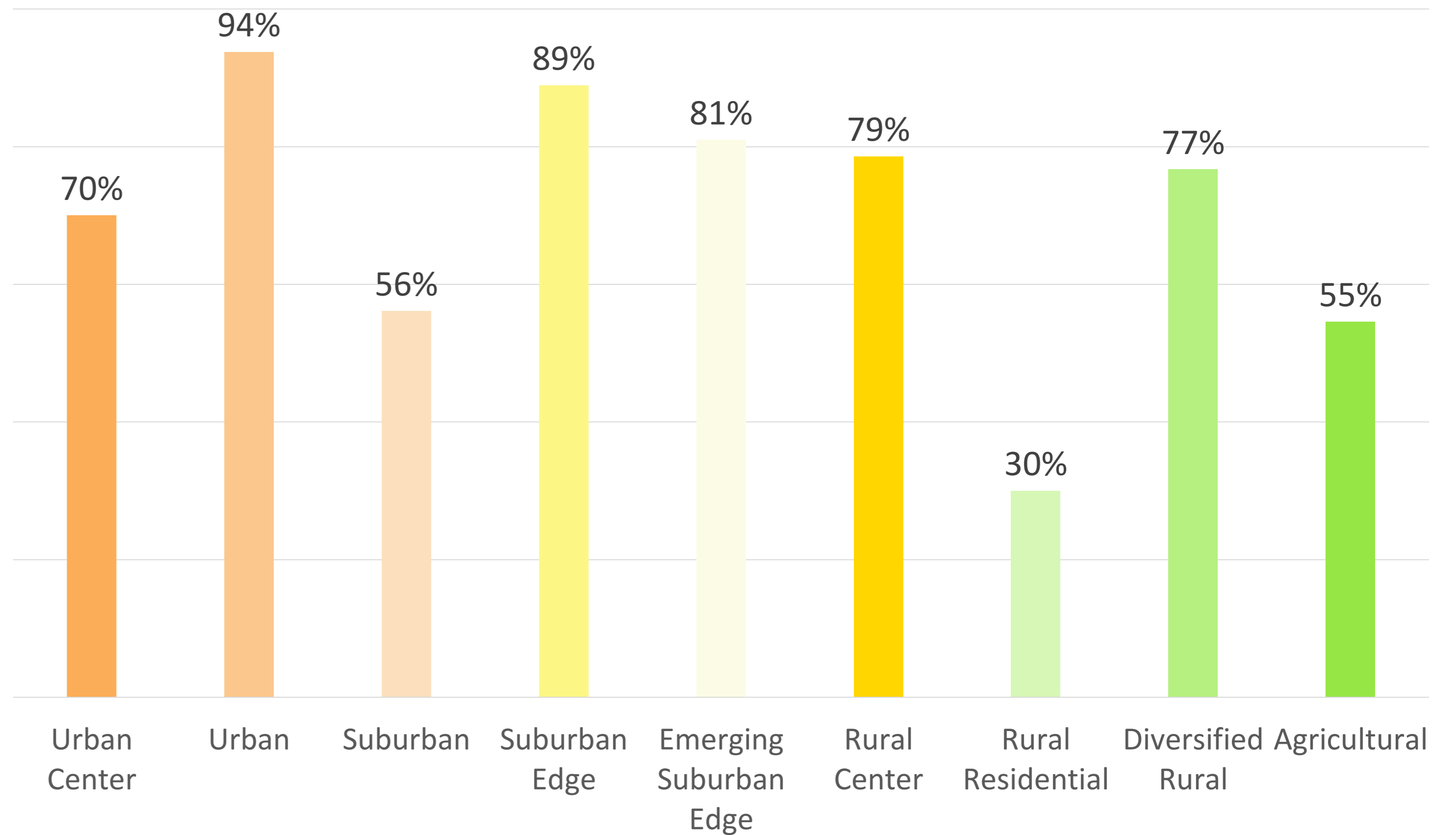
