

Rules for Riding

Pay Your Fare • Wear Shirts, Bottoms, & Shoes • One Fare = One Seat • Drinks Must Be Covered • Animals Must Be In A Carrier (Exception: Service Animals)


Sexual or Discriminatory Harassment • Phone Calls or Music Played On Speaker • Soliciting, Gambling, Panhandling, Loitering
Flammable or Other Hazardous Items • Large Items That Block the Aisle • Riding Bikes, Skating, Skateboarding • Vulgar Language • Eating

Interfering with Operator, Movement of Vehicle (Includes Holding Doors) • Disorderly Conduct • Smoking, Vaping, Illegal Drug Use • Sexual Assault Vandalizing or Littering • Threatening or Spitting On Others • Drinking Alcohol • Urinating or Defecating • Walking On Tracks, Trespassing















- Dispatched Calls Down -11.6% comparing Q1 2024 vs. Q1 2023


Arrests, Charges, & Prosecution: Case Investigations




Arrests, Charges, & Prosecution: Total Cases










Arrests, Charges, & Prosecution: City & County Attorney Charging








Arrests, Charges, & Prosecution: Pending Cases



TRIP Agents: By the Numbers

Started Feb. 23, 2024

500+ Fare Inspections Per Day

2,200+ Onboard Shifts

31,000+ Rider Interactions Since Launch

TRIP Agents

- Staffing Target: 24 Agents per day, 2 Shifts
- Current Staffing: 18 Agents, 5 starting in May
- 7 days a week, 6 a.m. through 10 p.m.

Resource for Riders

- Inspect fares & issue administrative citations
- Help with wayfinding, routes, & schedules
- Educate riders about Code of Conduct,
 Transit Assistance Program (TAP),
 & Transit Safety Intervention Project (TSIP)
- Administer first aid, CPR, & carry Narcan



- Help speed responses to *Text for Safety*


Bus Security Monitor Displays
