## **Objectives**

For each area of Council responsibility, achievable results that advance each regional goal

## **Policies**

Statement of the Council's intent and approach to regional issues or topics, independently and in its roles with partners

## **Actions**

Specific strategies or activities to implement policies and achieve goals
