The presentation covered the work being done by the Metro Transit Police Department to increase the safety of our transit and transit sites. This work includes increasing MT staffing through initiatives like the CSO Pathway Program, a proposed 2025 budget that would allow for up to 100 Transit Rider Investment Program (TRIP) employees by the end of 2025, and continuing their work with those involved in the Transit Service Intervention Project (TSIP), as well as their partnerships with surrounding sheriff's offices and other law enforcement agencies. In addition to this, they have increased their community outreach through their work with Saint Paul Downtown Alliance and Listening House of Saint Paul.
