




### **Use Estimate Background**

- Produced annually since 1995
- Used in formula to calculate regional park implementing agency share of:
  - Capital Improvement **Program dollars**
  - Parks and Trails Legacy Fund dollars
  - State funded Operations and Maintenance dollars









## **2013 Estimate: Counts**

#### **Regional Park System Counts** include:

- Regional Park System use **Memorial Day-Labor Day**
- Randomized selection of day/time/entrance
  - 2-hour time blocks
- Units only open to the public
  - 40 Regional Parks
  - 12 Park Reserves
  - 39 Regional Trails
  - 7 Special Recreation Features
  - 98 total units










