Assess risks from a changing climate and potentially rewards	 Identify potential competitive advantages we could magnify (e.g. water cluster; detailed urban temperature data)? Garner support for Transit funding through enhanced communication about climate change?
Create incentives to reward local governments that set and make progress on GHG reduction	 Pursue state funds to set up a grant program? Work with Council Finance to investigate providing credit support or loans to cities?

Collaborate and convene local governments and broader communities to address climate change	 Work with state agencies and local partners to provide sponsorship of events (EQB, PCA, DOC, DEED, MCWD, NARC and others)? Lead work with Science Museum on relevant display content? Convene metro stakeholders to be proactive and avoid non-attainment risk for criteria pollutants?
Invest to reduce energy use in buildings and operations, and be among leaders in the region	Pursue funding for audits and energy fixes on FAHP homes owned by Council/HRA?
