Overview of Application and Evaluation Process







LCA-TOD Purpose:

The Council's TOD grants (LCA-TOD) promote moderate to high density development projects located within walking distance of a major transit stop that typically include a mix of uses such as housing, jobs, restaurants, shops, and entertainment.

- March: Fund Distribution Plan; Notice of Funding Availability; Applicant Workshops, Design Workshops
- Project Concept Plans Due; Design Workshops II May:
- July: Applications Due, Step 1 Review - Staff
- September-October: Step 2 Review Livable **Communities Advisory Committee**
- **October: Community Development Committee, Full Council**
