






Prevalence by Disability Type






The prevalence of disabilities increases as people age






The prevalence of disabilities differ by race and ethnicity





The region is getting older



 Share of 65+ will increase to 22% in 2040




An older region means more adults with disabilities





Policy implications:

- Transportation: Metro Mobility and Metro Transit
- Housing:
 - Metro HRA: 48% of households have at least one person with a disability
 - Livable Communities Local Housing Incentives Account:
 Preference to projects that exceed the building code requirements for accessibility requirements
- Regional Parks: Accessibility in regional parks / trails
- Council as an employer:
 - 1.6% of Council employees report having a disabilities
 - 1% of Council hires report having a disabilities



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
