Background

Thrive MSP 2040 states the Council will strengthen equitable usage of regional parks and trails by all our region's residents, across race, ethnicity, income and ability. As part of this effort, the Council established the Parks Ambassador Program and in January 2017, hired a Senior Community Outreach Coordinator, Celina Martina, to lead the program.
