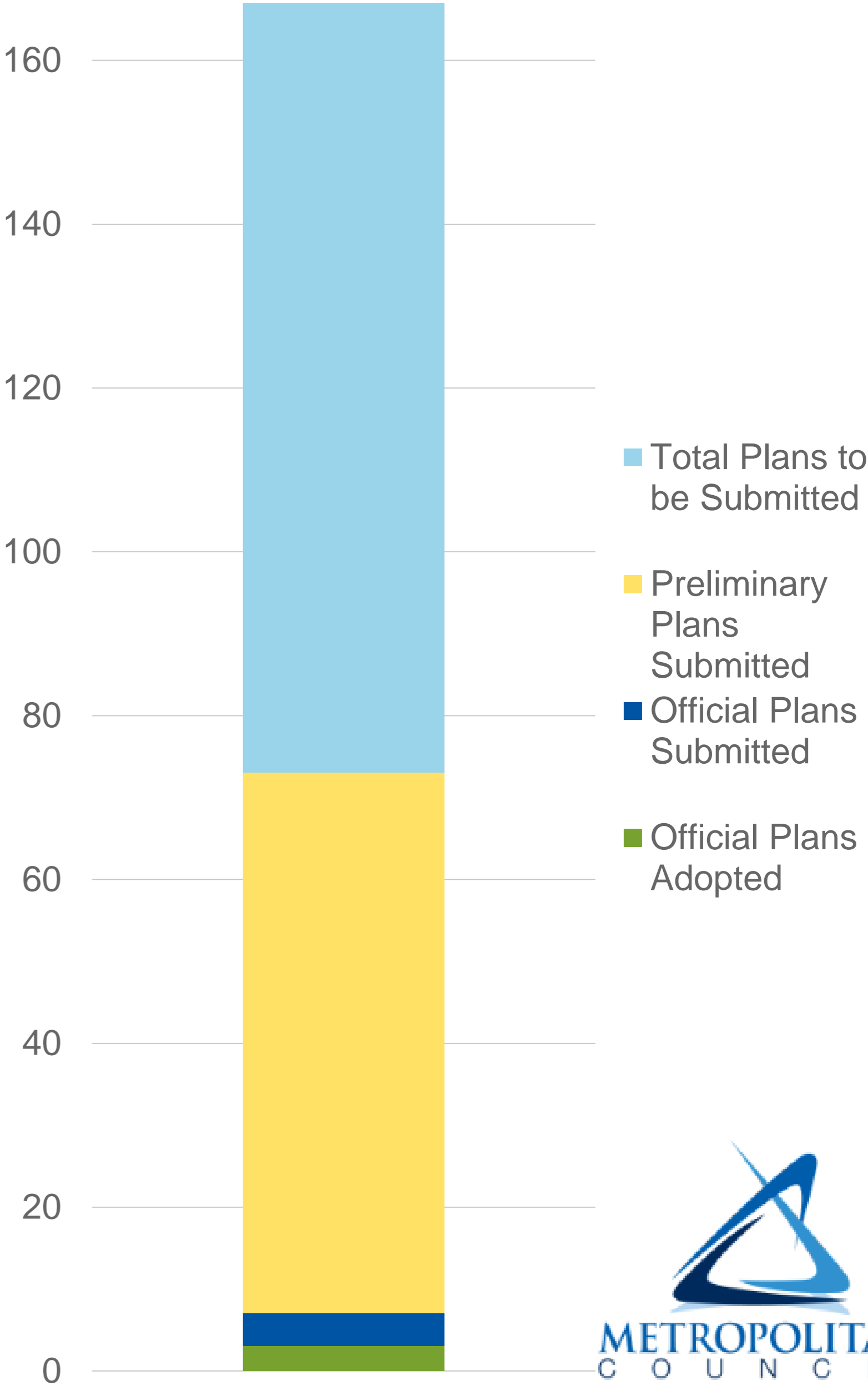

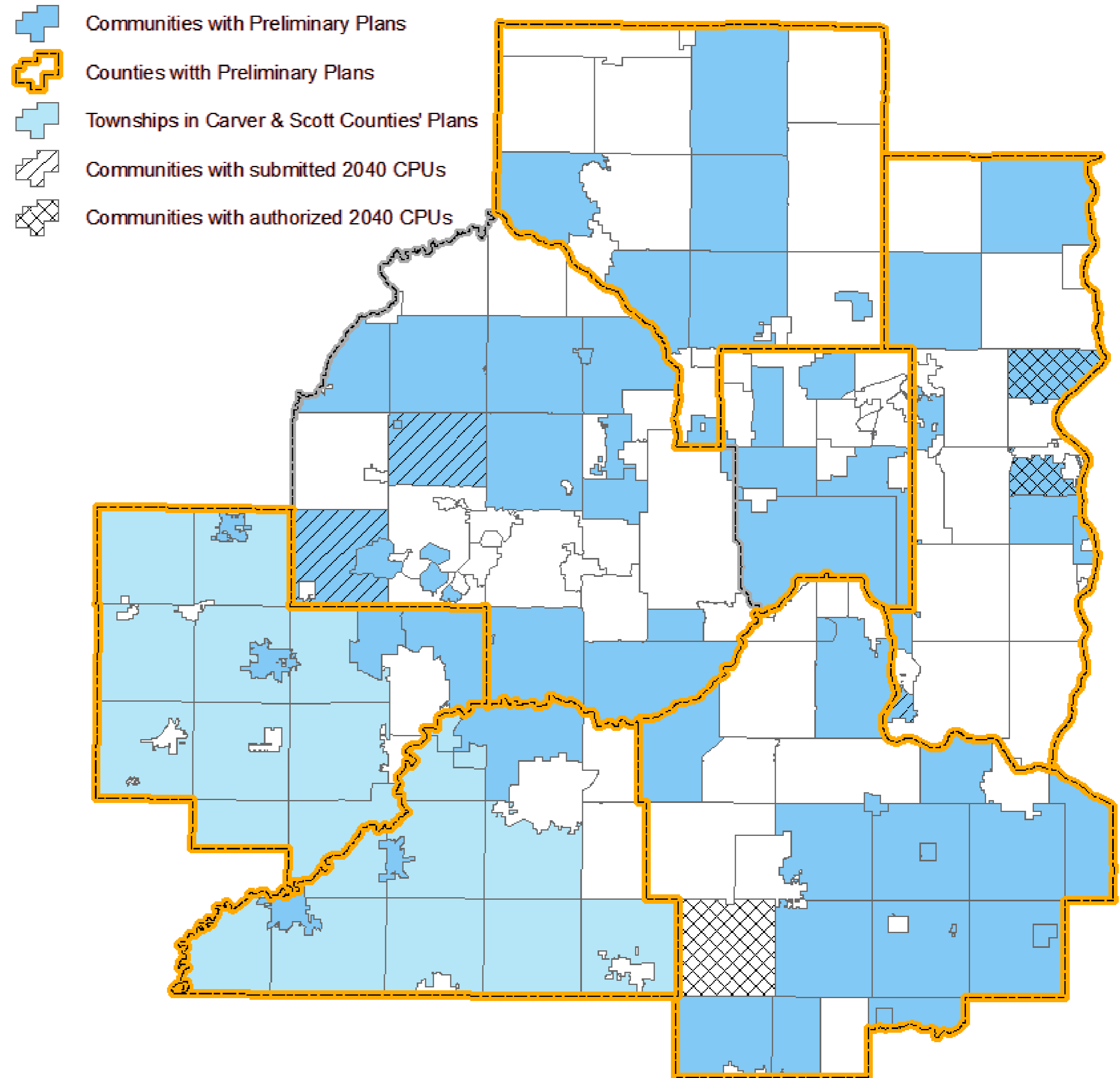
Where are we in the process?

- 167** Plans will be submitted
- 73** Preliminary Plans received so far
- 7** Official Plans have been submitted
- 3** Plans have been officially authorized



Who has submitted plans so far?

- 5 counties
- 53 cities
- 16 townships

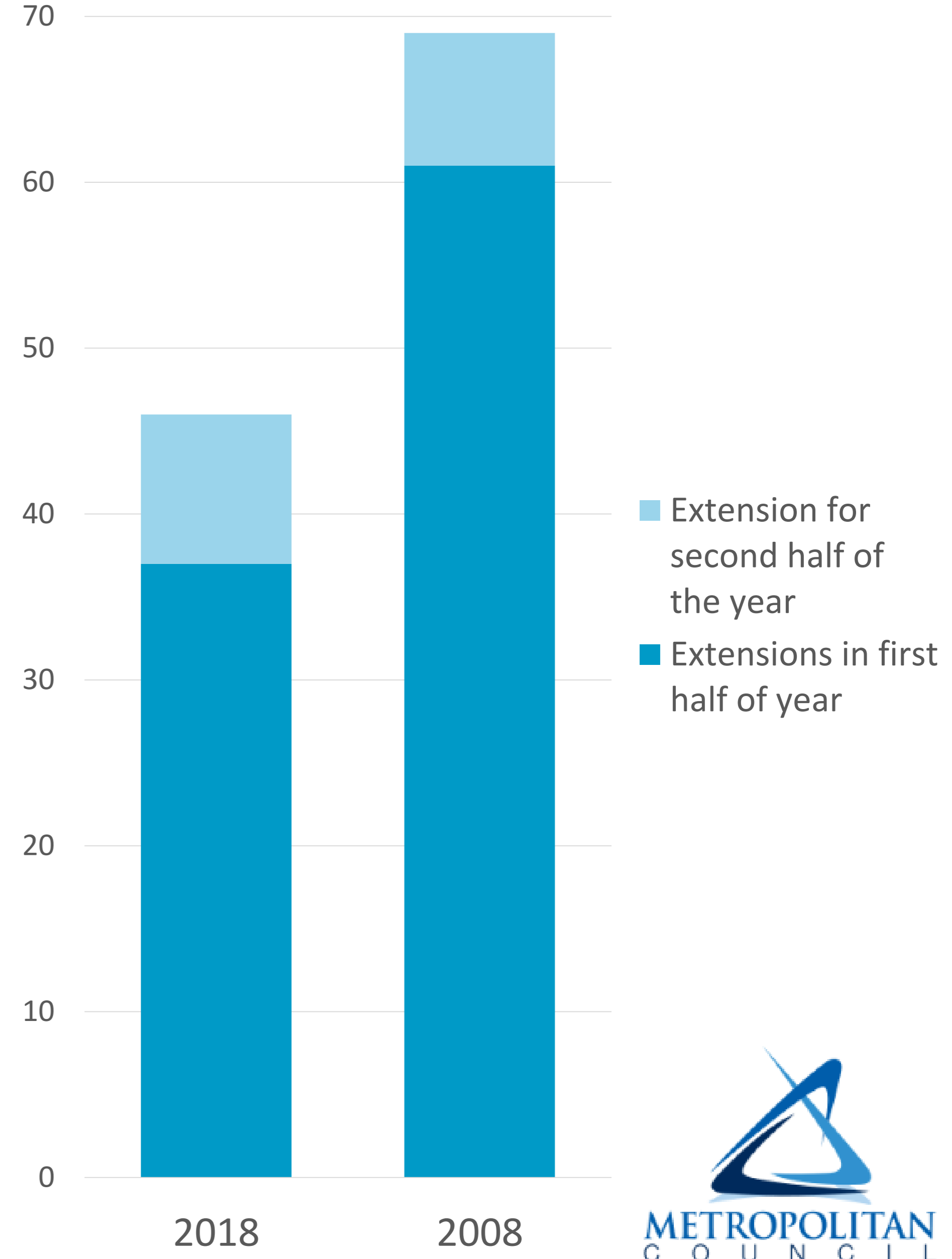


Extension Request Process

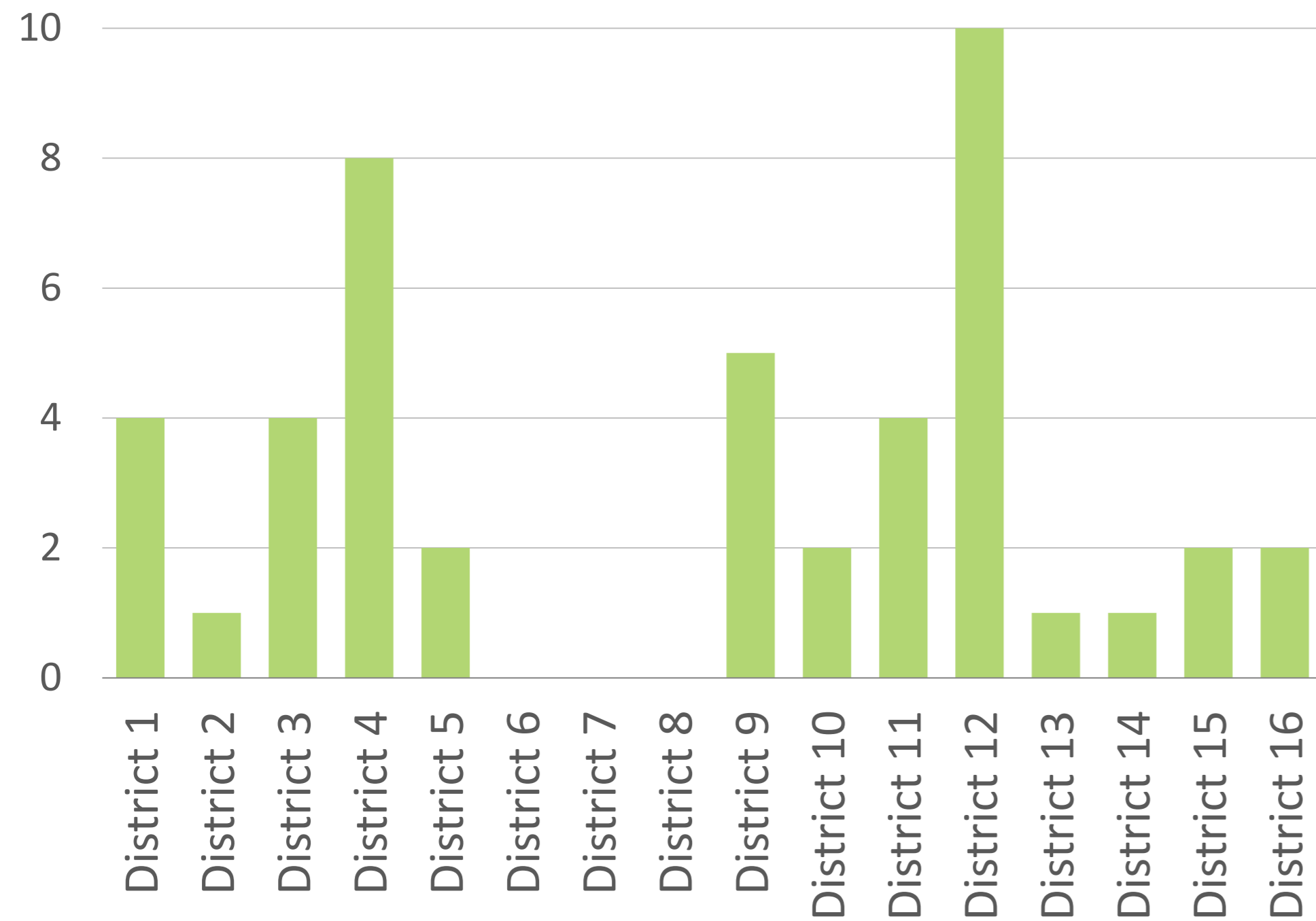
- Council authorized staff to administratively review and approve extension requests
- Application period to request an extension open through May 31, 2018
- Communities could request up to one additional year (December 31, 2019)
 - Does not change deadlines for Critical Area, surface water, water supply
- Required application materials
 - Local government resolution
 - Work plan
 - Timeline for completion of remaining items



Applications for Extensions

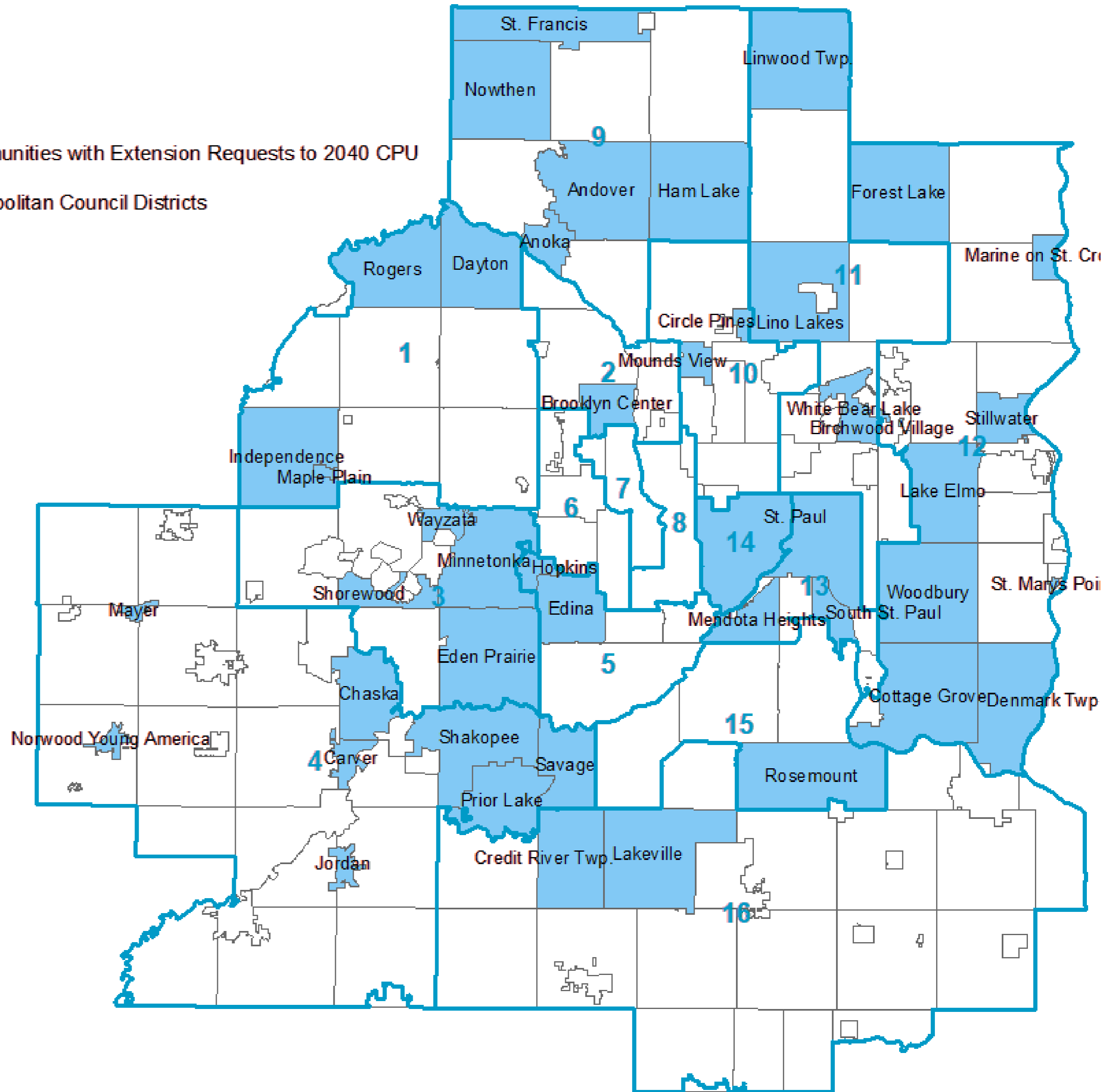
- 46** Total applications
- 37** Extensions in the first half of 2019
- 9** Extensions to September through end of year
- 5** Extensions for one full year



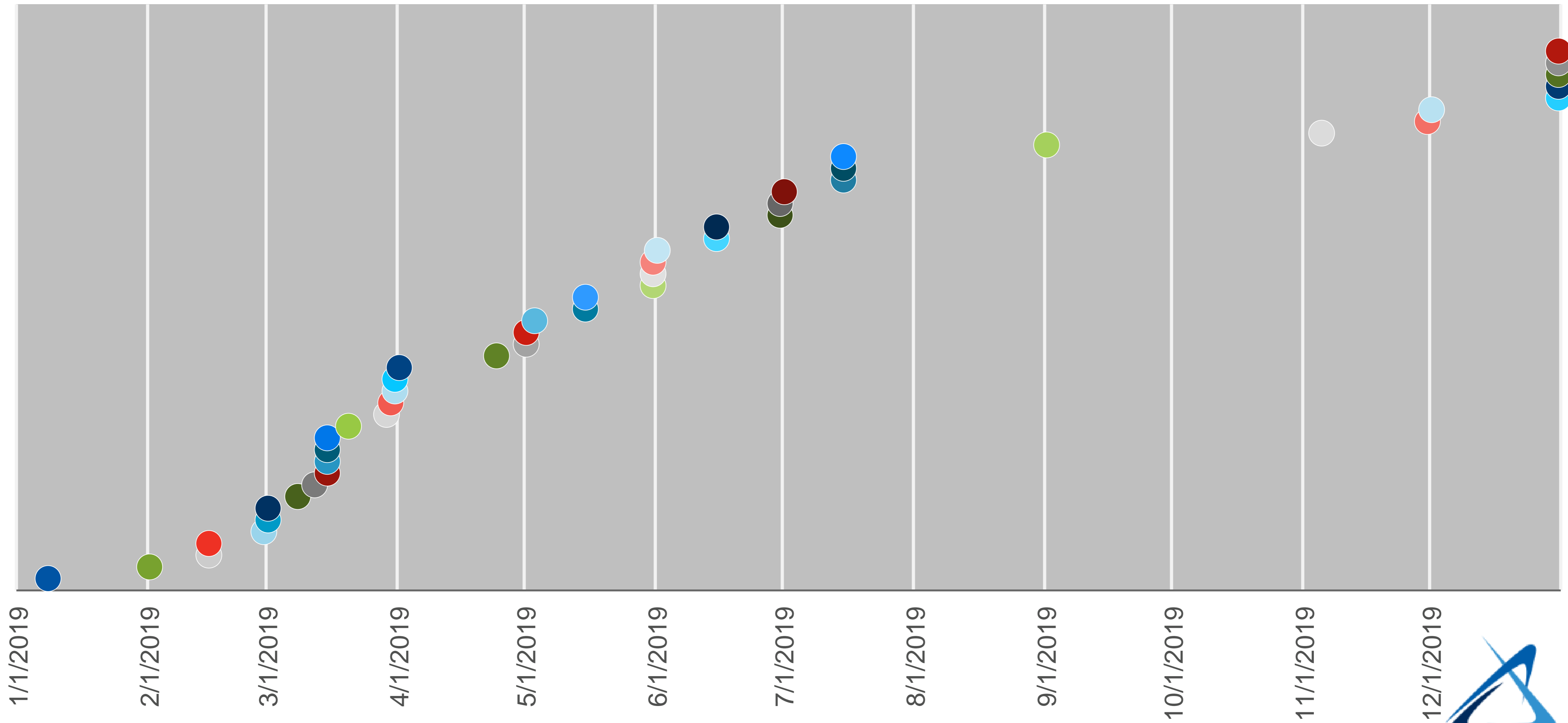
Who requested extensions?



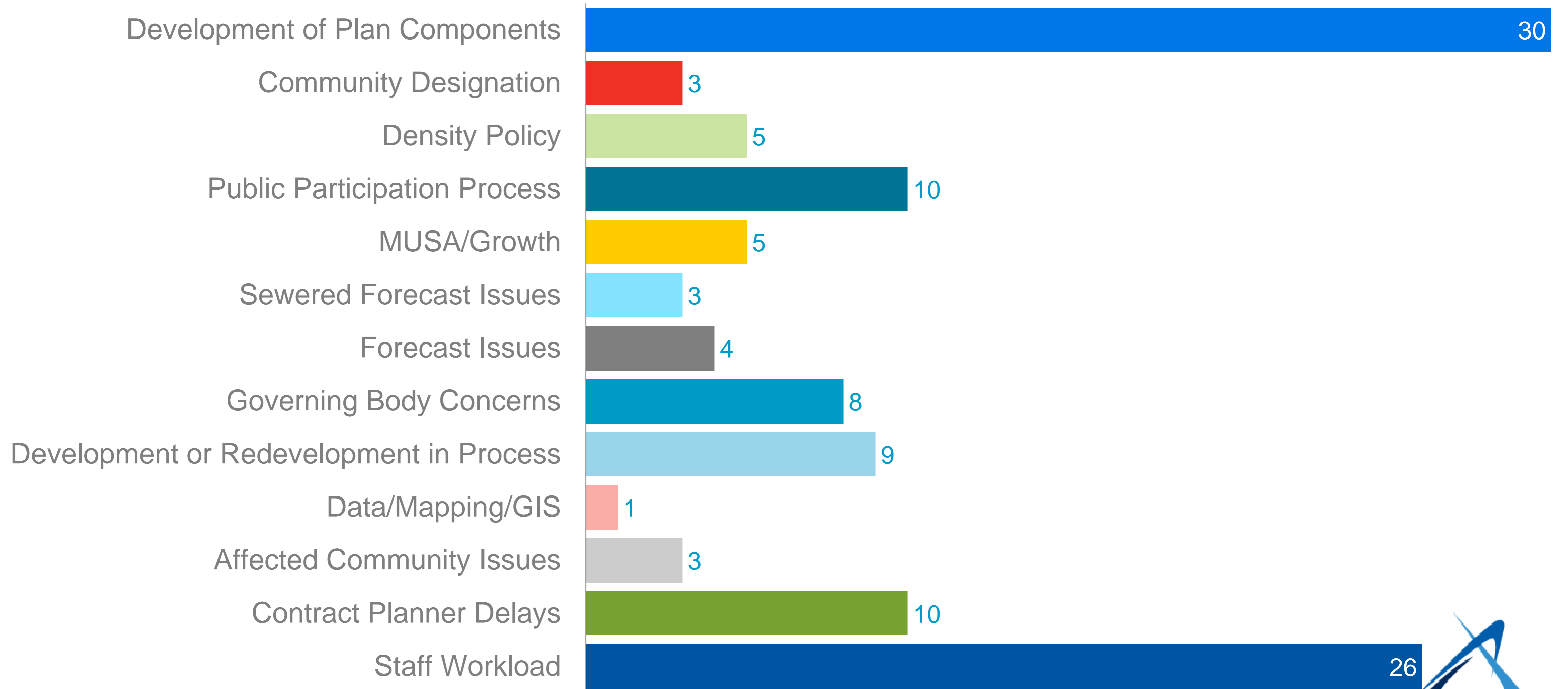
 Communities with Extension Requests to 2040 CPU

Timeline for extended submittals

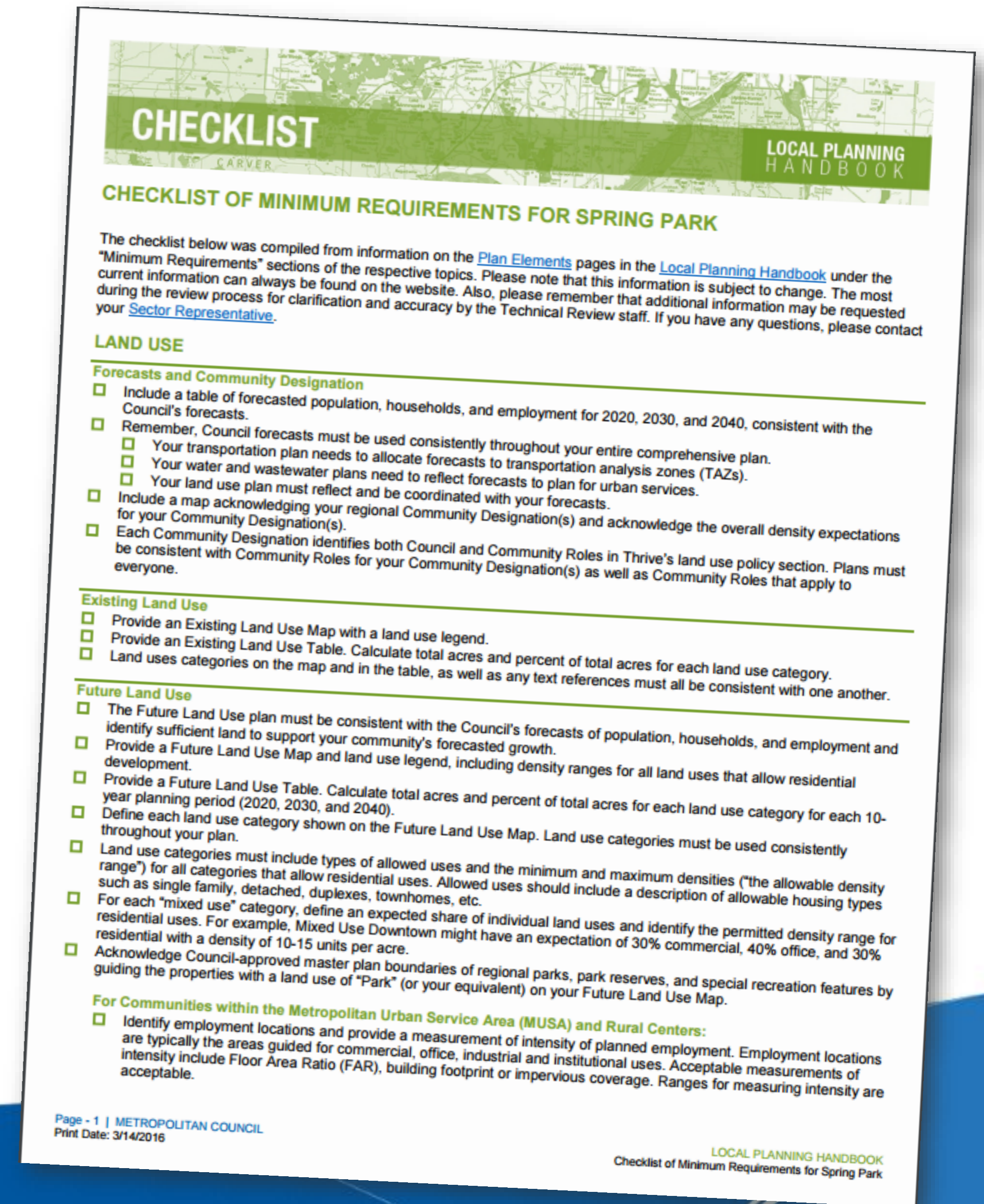


Planning Issues Cited



Preliminary Review Process

- Communities can submit draft versions the plan
- Council staff provide feedback on:
 - ☑ Completeness of information
 - ☑ Conformance issues
 - ☑ Any policy inconsistencies



Themes in Preliminary Reviews

- Excellent mapping
- Very few systems conformance issues
- Many plans have incorporated the resources provided in the Local Planning Handbook
- Discussion regarding equity connecting to community engagement efforts
- Incorporation of Regional Bicycle Transportation Network into local plans
- Inclusion of solar resources and policies
- Good climate action plans incorporated in some plans
- Equity in vision statements
