


Development Concepts

- Access to downtown Chanhassen, Minnesota Landscape Arboretum, Lake Minnetonka LRT Regional Trail
- Walking, jogging, in-line skating, bicycling, and other uses
- A 10-foot wide paved surface separated from vehicular traffic
- Wayfinding signage: kiosks, directional signs, rest stops, and traffic signage


