






Lake Byllesby Regional Park Context




Development Concepts

10-year Development Concept – East














Proposed Findings

The proposed master plan:

- is consistent with the requirements of the 2040 Regional Parks Policy Plan
- is consistent with Planning Strategy 1, and other Council policies.





Proposed Action

- Approve the Lake Byllesby Regional Park Master Plan.
- Approve master plan boundary adjustments to reflect the removal of three parcels and the addition of four parcels as shown in Figures 1 and 2.
- Require that Dakota County submit estimated land acquisition costs that were not quantified in this master plan as an amendment to the master plan for Metropolitan Council review and approval prior to seeking grants for acquisition of applicable parcels.
