




## Mississippi River Corridor **Critical Area (MRCCA)**













# Existing Land Use

## **Proposed Findings**

### **Township's 2040 Comprehensive Plan:**

- Conforms to regional system plans
- Consistent with Council policies
- Compatible with the plans of adjacent local governmental units and affected jurisdictions





### **Proposed Actions**

Adopt the attached Review Record and Advisory Comments, and

- Authorize Grey Cloud Island Township to place its 2040 Comprehensive Plan into effect.
- Advise the Township to:
  - Adopt the Mississippi River Corridor Critical Area component of their 2040 Comprehensive Plan within 60 days after receiving final approval from the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources (DNR); and submit a copy of the final adopted plan and evidence of adoption to the DNR, Council, and National Park Service within ten days after the adoption.
  - Forward a final copy of the Local Water Management Plan (LWMP) to the Council after South Washington Watershed District (SWWD) approves the LWMP and the Township adopts its LWMP, along with the SWWD approval date, and local adoption date of the final plan.
- Advise the Township to implement the advisory comments in the Review Record for Forecasts and Housing.
