

Findings

That the proposed amendment:

- Conforms to regional system plans
- Is consistent with Council policies
- Is compatible with the plans of adjacent and affected jurisdictions



Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council:

- Adopt the attached Review Record and allow the City of Shakopee to place the Windermere, The Willows, and BHS Comprehensive Plan Amendments (amendments) into effect.
- 2. Find that the proposed amendments do change the City's forecasts. The City will address all forecast adjustments, including both community-wide and TAZ forecasts, through the City's 2040 Comprehensive Plan.
- 3. Advise the City to implement the advisory comments in the Review Record for Transportation, Forecasts, Housing, and Stormwater.
