Proposed Findings

That the Plan:

- Conforms to Metropolitan system plans
- Consistent with Council policies
- Compatible with the plans of adjacent local governmental units and affected jurisdictions

Meeting Schedule

- Environment Committee on Tuesday, August 27
- Metropolitan Council on Wednesday, September 25

Proposed Action

- Authorize the City of Minneapolis to place its 2040 Comprehensive Plan into effect.
- Revise the City's forecasts upward as shown in Table 1 of the attached Review Record.
- Advise the City to:
 - Adopt the MRCCA Plan within 60 days after receiving the final DNR approval, and submit a copy of the final adopted plan and evidence of adoption to the DNR, Council, and National Park Service within 10 days after the adoption.
 - Implement the advisory comments in the Review Record for Transportation, Surface Water Management, and Water Supply.
 - Upon its completion, submit the updated Transportation Action Plan as an amendment to the 2040 Comprehensive Plan for Council review.
