2019 Funding Recommendation

That the Metropolitan Council:

- 1. Award three Livable Communities Demonstration Account Pre-Development grants for \$190,000.
- 2. Authorize its Community Development Division Director to execute the grant agreements on behalf of the Council.



Livable Communities Demonstration Account Purpose

The Livable Communities Demonstration Account (LCDA) funds development or redevelopment projects that *efficiently link housing, jobs, services, and transit* in an effort to create inspiring and lasting Livable Communities.



2019 Funding Availability


The Council approved:

- Up to \$500,000 for LCDA Pre-Development grants to be awarded in two application rounds with \$250,000 available in each Spring and Fall funding opportunity
- \$260,000 was awarded in the Spring round
 - \$10,000 was transferred from the Transit Oriented Development account to fully fund all eligible LCDA Pre-Development requests



Review Process

November 1, 2019: the Council received three LCDA Pre-Development applications



Applications undergo an evaluation by a staff team from the Community Development division




- Proposed infill multi-family residential project
