Proposed Changes for 2019

- Smaller jobs projects will be eligible and competitive with applications for Tax Base Revitalization Account grants
- Local Housing Incentives Account (LHIA) funds will be available for applications through sub-allocators as well as through Minnesota Housing
- Refinement to the Livable Communities Demonstration Account (LCDA) and LCDA Transit Oriented Development (TOD) engagement, jobs & design evaluation scoring





Proposed Changes for 2019-Continued

- Threshold criteria for TOD applications eliminated
- Consolidation of the Tax Base Revitalization Account (TBRA) TOD category into the regular TBRA program with \$900,000 more funding





Funding levels


- Local Housing Incentives Account: \$2.5 million
 - Statutory base funding: \$1.5 million
 - Propose adding \$1 million in existing fund balance
- Livable Communities Demonstration Account:
 - Historical regular category funding: \$7.5 million
 - Propose historical TOD category funding: \$5 million
- Tax Base Revitalization Account:
 - Statutory regular category funding: \$5 million
 - Propose adding \$900,000 in existing fund balance to the regular category
 - Propose SEED category funding: \$500,000
- Requires budget amendment to transfer in existing fund balances




TOD Eligible Areas

- The D Line will be eligible for development grants
- The Rush Line will be eligible for predevelopment grants


