Proposed Findings:

- That the plan:
 - Conforms to Metropolitan system plans;
 - Is consistent with Council policies, with proposed amendment to Suburban community designation; and
 - Is compatible with the plans of adjacent local governmental units and affected jurisdictions





Proposed Action:

- Authorize the City of Orono to place its 2040 Comprehensive Plan into effect.
- Advise the City:
 - That if changes are made to the City's water supply plan resulting from the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) review of the Plan, the City will need to provide the Council and the DNR with the updated information.
 - To provide the date the City adopts the final Local Water Management Plan (LWMP) to the Council when that Plan is approved. A copy of the final adopted LWMP that will be included in the final Plan document must be submitted to the Council, if it differs from the draft version the Council reviewed.
 - To revise Table 7 of the DNR template to reflect the fact that there are several systems in Orono, because the Water Supply chapter of the plan still shows inconsistent information from the Local Water Supply Plan (LWSP) submitted to the DNR.
 - To consider the advisory comments in the Review Record for Transportation, Forecasts, and Housing.
