







Regional Parks System Plan Map





Connections



This parcel is served by Metro Transit routes 54, 61, and 64, using White Bear Avenue, Maryland Avenue and Arcade Street as major streets within approximately one-half mile. The Bruce Vento Regional Trail forms the eastern boundary of the subject property.



Rationale for recommendation

- 2040 Regional Parks Policy Plan, Planning Policy, Strategy 1: The master plan, approved in 2011, specifically calls out this parcel for inclusion within the Councilapproved boundary;
- The City's request for 'future reimbursement consideration' is authorized by the **Regional Parks Fund Distribution Policy**;
- The property is eligible for funding through the 10% of our 2019 Parks and Trails Legacy Fund appropriation set aside by statute for land acquisition;
- The City of Saint Paul is well within its \$1.7 million-per-year limit for Parks and Trails Legacy Fund PAOF funding; and
- The property provides connection to the Bruce Vento Regional Trail, which abuts the parcel on the east.

Approve a grant of up to \$217,065.20 to the City of Saint Paul to acquire the 0.89-acre McKinney parcel located at 1298 Arlington Avenue East in the City of Saint Paul

Authorize the Community Development Director to execute the grant agreement and

Consider reimbursing the City of Saint Paul for up to \$72,355.21 from its share of a future Regional Parks Capital Bonding Program for costs associated with this purchase; and

Inform the City that the Council does not under any circumstances represent or guarantee that the Council will grant future reimbursement and that expenditure of local funds never
