Proposes to reguide an 8-acre site from Regional Commercial to High **Density Residential to allow** development for a multi-family residential project.











Findings

That the proposed amendment:

- Conforms to regional system plans
- Is consistent with Council policies, except for Natural Resources
- Is compatible with the plans of adjacent and affected jurisdictions
