Planned Residential Density






Existing Land Use

That the Plan:

- Conforms to Metropolitan system plans
- Consistent with Council policies, with the proposed changes
- Compatible with the plans of adjacent local governmental units and affected jurisdictions

Proposed Action

- Authorize the City of Deephaven to place its 2040 Comprehensive Plan into effect.
- Revise the City's forecasts for population, households, and employment as shown in Table 1 of the attached Review Record.
- Revise the City's affordable housing need allocation for 2021-2030 to 5 units.
- Strongly encourage the City to guide property at densities sufficient to support the development of housing to meets its affordable housing need allocation.
- Advise the City:
 - Prior to final Plan adoption, the Plan must be revised to acknowledge the City's affordable housing allocation need.
 - To be consistent with Council housing policy, the Plan should consider all widely available housing tools including CDBG and HOME funds through Hennepin County and Hennepin County AHIF funds.
 - To implement the advisory comments in the Review Record for land use.
