






Existing Land Use






2040 Future Land Use

- Revise the City's sewer-serviced forecasts upward as shown in Table 2 of the attached Review Record.
- Advise the City to:
 - Provide the date the City adopts the final LWMP and provide a copy of the final adopted LWMP for the Council's records.
 - Within 60 days after receiving DNR final approval, the City must adopt the MRCCA Plan, and submit a copy of the final adopted plan and evidence of adoption to the DNR, Council, and National Park Service within 10 days after the adoption.
 - Implement the advisory comments in the Review Record for Forecasts, Land Use, and Water Supply.
