




# **Rum River Regional Trail**



# **Proposed Requests**

- Underpass: Adding an underpass at CSAH 14/Bridge Street to increase safety
- Trail Realignment: Realigning the planned trail to provide a higher quality natural resource experience.




# Underpass

- Removes current at-grade crossing of Bridge Street, which is a two-lane, 40mile per hour roadway
- Adds an underpass with 10-foot wide paved trail





### Trail Realignment



- Segment 1 (Quay Street to 235 Avenue): Existing 0.2mile existing trail
- Segment 2 (Quay Street to the Isanti/Anoka County boarder): Undeveloped 3mile trail with a minimum of two proposed scenic overlooks and rest stops
- Alternative Route along 244th Street: 1.0-mile signed on-street bike alternate route east to Verdin Street.




