




Planned Residential Density



- Revise the City's Affordable Housing Need Allocation to 795.
- Advise the City to:
 - Adopt the Mississippi River Critical Corridor Area (MRCCA) Plan within 60 days after receiving final DNR approval, and submit a copy of the final adopted plan and evidence of adoption to the DNR, Council, and National Park Service within 10 days after the adoption.
 - Implement the advisory comments in the Review Record for Forecasts, Housing, and Water Supply.
