





Rationale for recommendation

- <u>Consistent</u> with:
 - The 2040 Regional Parks
 Policy Plan;
 - State fiscal year 2021 Parks and Trails Legacy Fund (PTLF) appropriation requirements;
 - The Grey Cloud Island Regional Park master plan; and
 - Washington County is within it's \$1.7 million per fiscal year limit for PTLF PAOF funding.



Recommendations

- Approve a grant of up to \$261,525 to Washington County for the 41.15-acre Kulvich property located at 11523 Grey Cloud Trail South in the City of Cottage Grove for Grey Cloud Island Regional Park, contingent on Council approval of the July 2020 Special Budget Amendment, Business Item 2020-182 JT and on the anticipated closing date occurring before the purchase agreement expiration date.
- Authorize the Community Development Director to execute the grant agreement and restrictive covenant on behalf of the Council.
