



Vermillion River Greenway Regional Trail






Community Engagement

Dakota County's Visitor Services Master Plan (2017)

- Provide safe and accessible facilities
- Provide clear signage and other amenities
- Provide information about regional park and recreation facilities

Master plan-focused outreach

- Add lighting in wooded portions of trail corridor
- Add amenities, improve area around Vermillion Falls
- Develop the new trail segment away from County Road 46







Overall Development Concept

- The Master Plan identifies the preferred regional trail alignment, alternative alignments, trailheads, gateways, and gradeseparated crossings.
- The Vermillion River Greenway Regional Trail will integrate linear recreation, non-motorized transportation, water quality improvements, habitat preservation and interpretation.
- Dakota County is committed to providing universal accessibility at all trail facilities.






Estimated Project Costs

- Dakota County estimates 19.4 acres
 (5.35 miles) of land is needed to secure
 the trail corridor.
- Development cost estimates include:
 - trail construction
 - wayfinding signage
 - site furnishings (e.g., benches, drinking fountains, bicycle racks)
 - lighting
 - vegetation improvements
 - water quality improvements
- Approval of master plan does not commit the Council to any funding at this time.

Development	\$3,842,660
Total	\$6,384,980

Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council:

- Approve Dakota County's Vermillion River Greenway Regional Trail (Hastings) Master Plan.
- 2. Require Dakota County, prior to initiating any new development of the regional trail corridor, to send preliminary plans to the Metropolitan Council's Environmental Services Division Assistant Manager.
