






# Existing Land Use

# Proposed Findings

## That the Plan:

- Conforms to Metropolitan system plans
- Consistent with Council policies, with proposed forecast revision
- Compatible with the plans of adjacent local governmental units and affected jurisdictions

# Proposed Action

- Authorize the City of Ramsey to place its 2040 Comprehensive Plan into effect.
- Revise the City's forecasts upward as shown in Table 2 and Table 3 of the attached Review Record.
- Advise the City that per state statute resolutions adopting comprehensive plans cannot be based on contingent approval by the Metropolitan Council. Minnesota Statutes, section 473.585, subdivision 3, states: Comprehensive "plans shall be submitted to the council following recommendation by the planning agency of the unit and after consideration but before final approval by the governing body of the unit." (emphasis added). Submission of an adopting resolution inconsistent with state statute may jeopardize the City's access to necessary permits or eligible grant programs.



# Proposed Action (continued)

- Advise the City to:
  - Adopt the Mississippi River Critical Corridor Area (MRCCA) Plan within 60 days after receiving final DNR approval, and submit a copy of the final adopted plan and evidence of adoption to the DNR, Council, and National Park Service within 10 days after the adoption.
  - When available, provide to the Council the date the City adopted the final Local Water
     Management Plan, and a copy of the final adopted Local Water Management Plan.
  - Implement the advisory comments in the Review Record for land use, water supply, and plan implementation.
