Requirements for LCA – Local Housing Incentives Account participation

Communities must:

- Adopt affordable and life-cycle housing goals
- Establish a Housing Action Plan
- Spend an affordable and life-cycle housing opportunity amount (ALHOA)



2021-2030 affordable and life-cycle housing goals

- Affordable and Life-cycle Housing Goals are updated every decade
- 58 communities adopted 2021-2030 affordable and life-cycle housing goals prior to November 15, 2020
- Opportunity to enroll in the program on an annual basis, but enrollment requires adopting 2021-2030 housing goals regardless of when enrollment occurs
