Project Evaluation and Ranking



- Applications submitted to Minnesota Housing
- Multiple Stages of Review

- Proposer's Organizational Capacity
- Project Financial Feasibility
- Overall Match with Funding Partner Priorities
  - Addressing specific and critical local housing needs
- Preserve housing with Federal project-based rent assistance
- Prevent and end homelessness



### Application Process

- Selection Committee allocates funds
  - Based on composite rank and best use of partners' funding sources
- Not all applicants request LHIA funds
- Some projects have their need met solely with one funding source, such as tax credits




