### Background

In preparation for upcoming work planning discussions for the Community Development Committee, Council staff will report out on the efforts related to the Council’s Housing Goal identified in the [Metropolitan Council Strategic Plan](#). Council staff will also seek feedback from the Committee on prioritizing efforts in 2021 to ensure that staff work plans are aligned with Committee expectations.

Staff will seek feedback from Committee members on efforts that are categorized as “Special Projects / Initiatives” in Table 1 below, as these strategies in particular involve efforts that are in addition to the core work that staff perform related to statutory and federal requirements.
