 - Mobility Demonstration Program will expand on the findings of this research






Study Design

- Phase 1: Random assignment of families into two groups
 - First two years of enrollment
 - Comprehensive Mobility Related Services (CMRS), Control
- Phase 2: Random assignment of families into three groups
 - Last three years of enrollment
 - CMRS, Selected Mobility Related Services (SMRS), Control


