
Background

Why are community designations important?


- Further regional policy outcomes

- Protect agricultural land and natural amenities




Metropolitan Development Framework Guide, 1975




Metropolitan Development and Investment Framework, 1986




Regional Blueprint, 1996





Regional Development Framework, 2004
