Requirements for LCA - Local Housing Incentives Account participation

Communities must:

- Adopt affordable and life-cycle housing goals
- Have a housing action plan
- Spend an affordable and lifecycle housing opportunity amount (ALHOA)

2021-2030 affordable and life-cycle housing goals

- Affordable and life-cycle housing goals are updated every decade
- 17 communities adopted 2021-2030 affordable and lifecycle housing goals prior to November 15, 2021
- Opportunity to enroll in the program on an annual basis, but enrollment requires adopting 2021-2030 housing goals regardless of when enrollment occurs
