
Program COVID Impacts



Summary of HUD Report

- HUD wants to see increased leasing to 98% nationally by year end 2022 •
- HCV family loss of income ulletIncreases in average subsidy costs Ο
- Voucher turnover rates dropped
- Reduction in new admissions and portability
- Influx of CARES Act funds
 - Results in higher than ever reserve levels •

The HCV program hit an all-time low leasing level of **86.9%** in 2021

Vouchers on Street at End of Month



Spending and Average Subsidy Cost


National

Average Subsidy continues to rise

Spending was down at end of 2021 resulting in increased reserves

Metro HRA

Average Subsidy Jan 2020 = \$785 Average Subsidy April 2022 = \$944 Spent 97.5% of funds in 2021






Non-Elderly Disabled (NED) Program



Awarded in 2021 through the American Rescue Plan, serves people experiencing homelessness, at risk of homelessness or fleeing domestic violence

What to do . . . Considerations

Funding

- 2022 Funding = \$75,961
- Funding will allow leasing (close to) full baseline
- Carry-over funds from 2021
- Appear eligible for 2022 set-aside funds
- Monitor spending closely

Voucher Success

- Success rates down
- Updated Waiting List
- Intentional outreach to voucher holders
- Opening waiting list
- Provide housing search assistance
- Assistance with deposits and application fees

Landlord Strategies

- Conduct landlord outreach and engagement
- Landlord education
- Expedited inspections
- Use risk mitigation funds

Waiting List Opening

Metro HRA Housing Choice Voucher Waiting List to Open

- Online applications will be available June 22-28, 2022
- Applicants may apply any time during the open period
- 2,000 applicants will be placed on the waiting list through random draw
- 95% of waiting list placements for applicants who live in seven-county metro area.
 - Remaining 5% will be awarded to any other applicants.
- Extensive community engagement
- Future CDC Information Item on result of waiting list opening.



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
