




## **Existing Planned Land Use**

## That the Plan:

- Conforms to regional system plans

- Is compatible with the plans of adjacent and affected jurisdictions

## **Proposed Action**

## That the Metropolitan Council:

- 1. Authorize the City of Bethel to place its 2040 Comprehensive Plan into effect.
- Require the City provide to the Council the date the City adopted the final Local Water
  Management Plan, and a send a copy of the final Local Water Management Plan if it differs from
  the draft version, dated September 2019.
- 3. Advise the City to implement the advisory comments in the Review Record for forecasts, housing, and water supply.
