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



Scoring Framework



Proposed Scoring Criteria Updates

Clarity and Consistency in 2023:

- Jobs scores rooted in a broader definition of economic • opportunity
- Scoring redundancies eliminated
- Adjustments to new Policy Development program: • minimum score, more weight on outcomes
- Plain language updates to ensure wording is • understandable and clear

Looking ahead to 2024:

- Evaluation, strategic consideration of program changes \bullet
- Participant and stakeholder feedback
- Geographic distribution assessment

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Plain Language Update - Example

Previous text

The project team, including partners, is designed to reflect and be responsive to those underrepresented and most impacted by the project; or the predevelopment activities will seek to build such partnerships in a meaningful way

Updated text

Those with decision-making power reflect the community the project will serve; or, the predevelopment activities will build a reflective team.

(LCDA and TOD Predevelopment)

Jobs Language Update - Example

Previous text

Create or preserve permanent employment opportunities (priority for projects with living wage jobs)

Support economic growth of the community through expanded jobs, options supporting cooperatively owned businesses or supporting the economic stability of the community the project is intending to serve.

Updated text

Create or preserve permanent jobs **OR create workforce development/ training opportunities:** priority for projects with full-time, living wage jobs

Support economic stability and/or growth for those experiencing the largest economic hardships through the business model, training programs, or project mission.

Policy Development: Outcomes Language

Previous text

Furthering equitable outcomes in...

Extent to which the policy will support achieving more equitable development outcomes

Updated text

Realize more equitable outcomes in ...

Support more equitable development outcomes in physical developments and/or through city process to approve physical developments

Scoring adjustments

- Increase points for "WHAT" -
- Decrease points for "HOW" —
- New minimum score: 25 of 50 possible points —
