


## Funding Availability



- Part of larger development on Brooklyn Center's Opportunity Site.




## The Unity Building

- Create a 4-story building to support small businesses owned by immigrants and residents of color.



- Services for residents offered by local service providers



- Emphasis on environmental sustainability




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
