
Regional Systems



Amendment Details

- Update to language relating to historic structures in the Lower St. Croix River District.
- Requide 15 acres from Land Use category Rural Residential to Urban Residential. The Urban Residential land use, which permits 1.45 units per acre, is intended to preserve, but not expand, the historic platting pattern of the City's oldest residential areas.
- Expansion of the Urban Residential area results in a policy inconsistency.
- No development is associated with this amendment.

Proposed Land Use



Findings



That the proposed amendment:

- Conforms to regional system plans
- Is consistent with Council policies, except for regional land use policy
- Is compatible with the plans of adjacent and affected jurisdictions
- There is no regional or system impact resulting from the proposed change.

Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council:

- 1. Authorize the City of Marine on St. Croix to place its comprehensive plan amendment into effect.
- 2. Find that the amendment does not change the City's forecasts.
- 3. Advise the City to implement the advisory comments in the Review Record for Land Use.



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
