Call to Order

1. **2024-270** City of Elko New Market R & F Properties Comprehensive Plan Amendment, Review File 22468-5 (MacKenzie Young-Walters 651-602-1373)

It was moved by Wulff, seconded by Vento that the Metropolitan Council adopt the attached Review Record and take the following actions:

1. Authorize the City of Elko New Market to place its comprehensive plan amendment into effect.

2. **2024-271** Signature Authorization for City of St. Paul Pass-Through Grant - Wakan Tipi (Erin Acton 651-602-1938)

It was moved by Wulff, seconded by Vento that the Metropolitan Council authorize the Community Development Executive Director to execute the grant agreement and amendment(s) for SFY 2024 Legislatively Designated Pass-through Program grant to the City of St. Paul for the Wakan Tipi Center (SG-24P6-07-02), in accordance with Table 1.

 2024-272 North Creek Greenway Regional Trail, Park Acquisition Opportunity Fund Award (Oliver), Dakota County (Jessica Lee 651-602-1621) It was moved by Wulff, seconded by Vento that the Metropolitan Council: Approve a grant of up to \$117,384 from the Park Acquisition Opportunity Fund to Dakota County to acquire a 20.43-acre parcel located on Vermillion River Trail in Empire, MN, for the North Creek Greenway Regional Trail.

 2024-273 Miesville Ravine Park Reserve, Park Acquisition Opportunity Fund Award (Schwamb), Dakota County (Jessica Lee 651-602-1621) It was moved by Wulff, seconded by Vento that the Metropolitan Council: Approve a grant of up to \$388,910 from the Park Acquisition Opportunity Fund to Dakota County to acquire a 5-acre parcel located at 26287 Miesville Trail in Douglas Township, MN, for the Miesville Ravine Park Reserve.

1. **2024-289** Authorizing Submittal of Pathways to Removing Obstacles to Housing, FY 2024 Application to U.S. Dept. of Housing and Urban Development (Sarah Berke 651-602-1198) It was moved by Wulff, seconded by Johnson that the Metropolitan Council:

1. Authorize the Executive Director of the Community Development Division to finalize and submit a grant application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the "Pathways to Removing Obstacles to Housing" (PRO Housing) program.

2. Commit \$3 million in Local Housing Incentive Account grants, no later than in the years 2027-2028, as leverage for the PRO Housing grant, if awarded.

The committee expressed interest in learning more about the FY 2023 PRO Housing grant activities. Berke indicated that this could be added as an informational update for the committee calendar in the future, once the grant activities are finalized with HUD. The committee also discussed the impact of climate change and challenging property insurance markets as an increasing barrier to housing.

 2024-274 City of Marine on St. Croix Historic Riverway Buildings and Rosabelle Future Land Use Comprehensive Plan Amendment, Review File 22256-2 (Emma Dvorak 651-602-1399)

It was moved by Vento, seconded by Wulff that the Metropolitan Council adopt the attached Review Record and take the following actions:

1. Authorize the City of Marine on St. Croix to place its comprehensive plan amendment into effect.

2. Find that the amendment does not change the City's forecasts.

3. Advise the City to implement the advisory comments in the Review Record for Land Use.
